

2ST031 Quantitative Research Methods for the Social Sciences

Examination and grading

The course is divided into two parts. In order to pass the course, you need to pass both parts.

Grading

U: Not pass

G: Pass

VG: Pass with distinction

Part 1 (Graded U, G or VG)

In order to pass you should

- 1) Submit the short report on the article seminar and get grade G (Graded U or G).
- 2) Submit the home examination and get G or VG (Graded U, G or VG)
Maximum points: 30
VG: at least 26 ($\geq 85\%$)
G: at least 18 ($\geq 60\%$)

If you do not pass the home examination, you can choose

- 1) to do a completion to the home examination, but in this case you will not be able to achieve VG grade, or
- 2) to do a re-examination.

Part 2 (Graded U or G)

In order to pass you should

- 1) Work in groups. Write a report where you analyze data (own or taken from the course homepage). Submit the report before deadline.
- 2) Have an oral presentation of your work during the End Seminar.
- 3) Perform an opposition of another report during the End Seminar.

The total grade on the course is an appraisal of both parts.

To get VG on the whole course you will need to get:

Part 1: VG Part 2: G

General note: PhD students only get grade U or G.
